Peer-Assisted Learning (SI and Tutoring)

Periodic, structured opportunities to reflect and integrate learning

Goals

Lower attrition rates in historically difficult courses

Improve learning and student grades

Increase student graduation rates

How?

Students learn how to process information.

Students gain experience applying effective study strategies.

Students become more actively engaged in the course.

Supplemental Instruction

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Supports 32-35 high-enrollment, "traditionally difficult" courses
Fall 2013
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2,032 student participants 7,323 SI session visits

Winter 2014
1,698 student participants
6,817 SI session visits

SI participants earn ½ to 1 full letter grade higher than students who do not participate in SI.
