








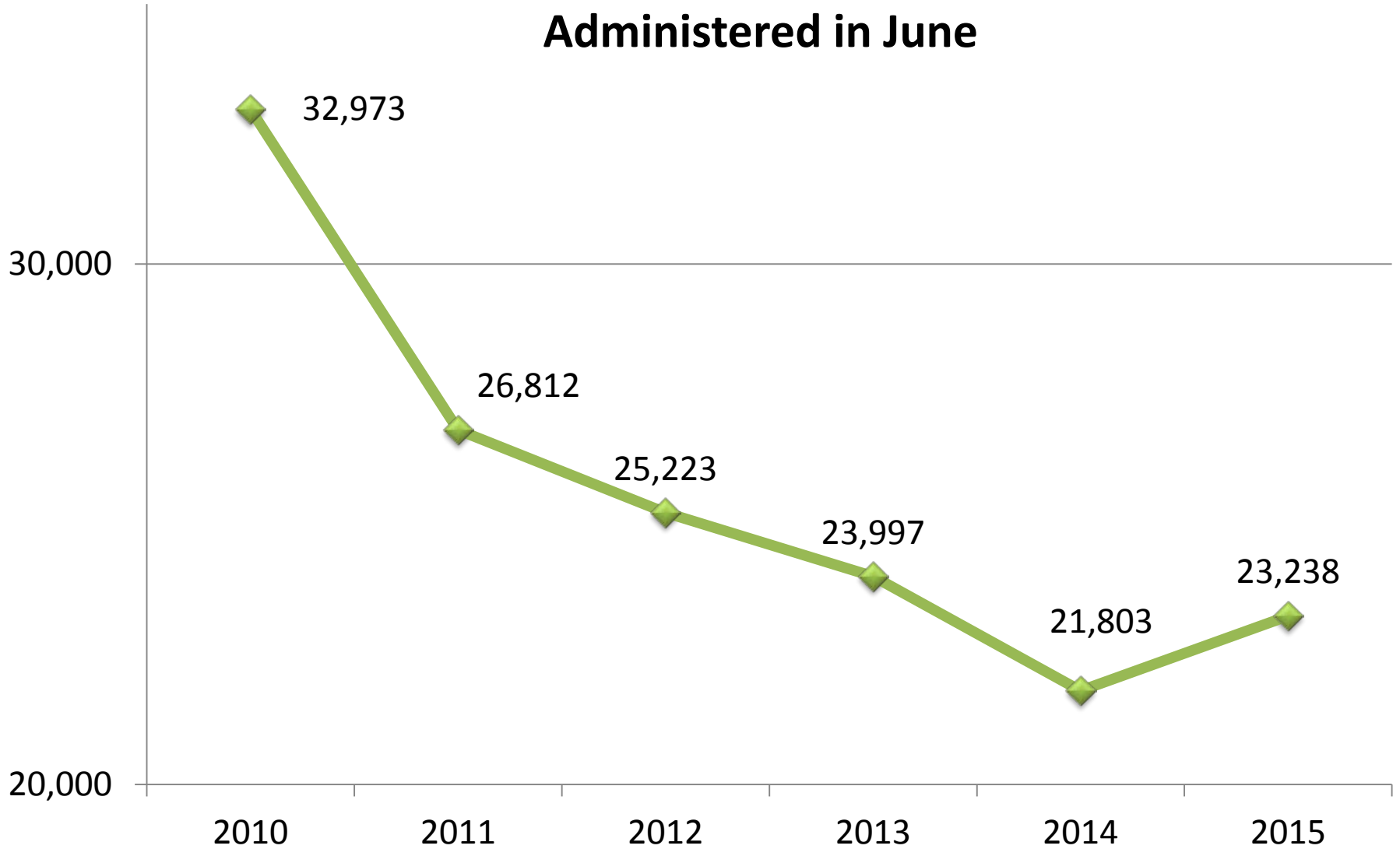

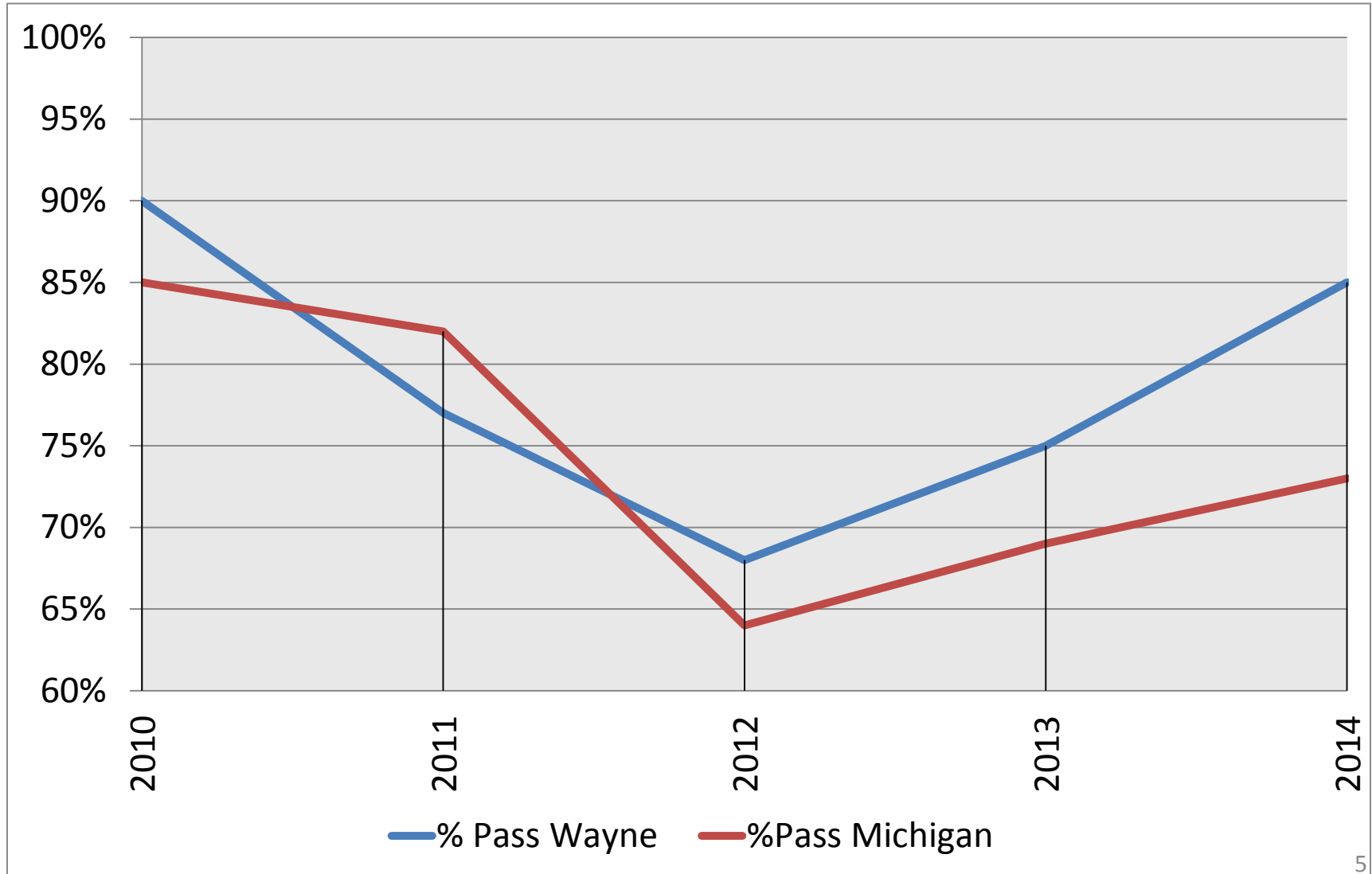
Total Law School Aptitude Tests (LSAT) Administered in June



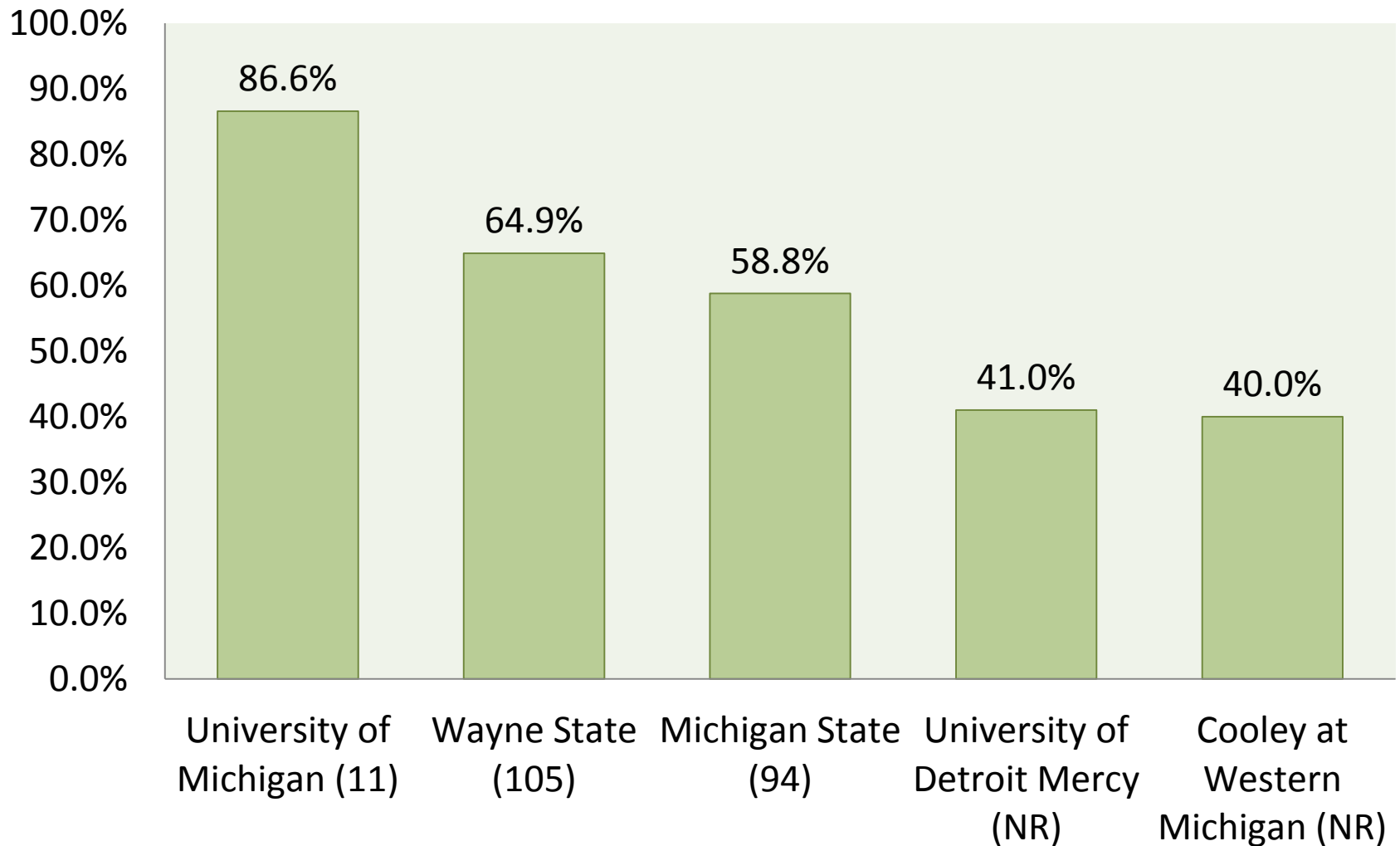


- ❖ Philip C. Jessup International Law Moot Court Team won U.S. Midwest Regional of Competition and Best Memorial and Best Oralist.

- ❖ Student Trial Advocacy Program won first place in the TYLA Regional competition, advancing to the Nationals round.

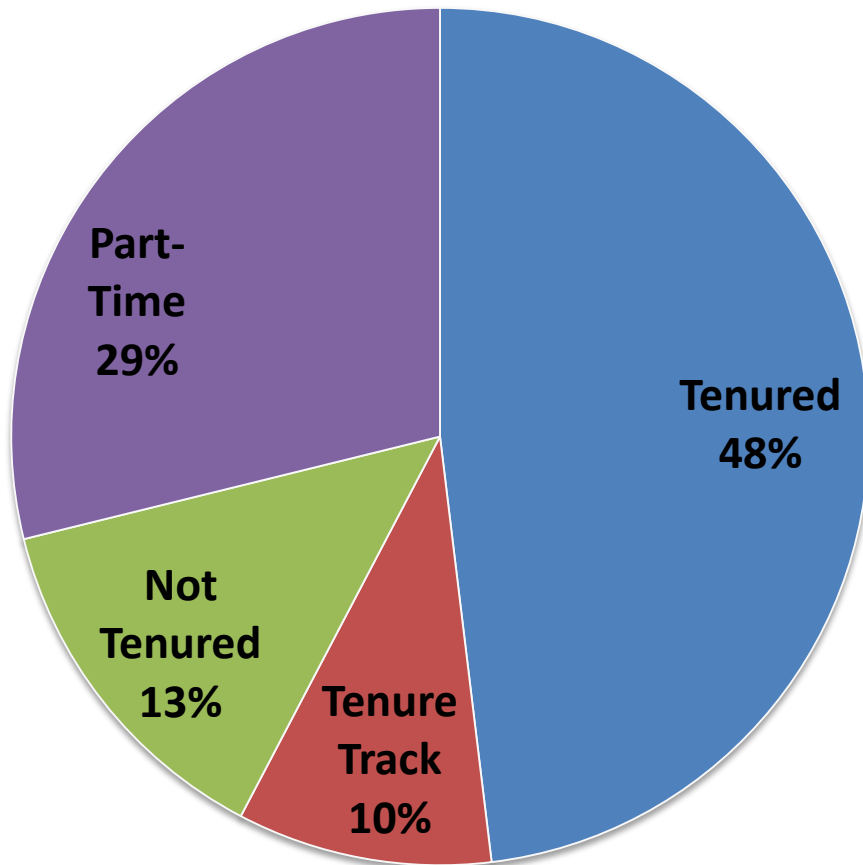
Wayne Law Compared to State of Michigan Bar Passage Rates



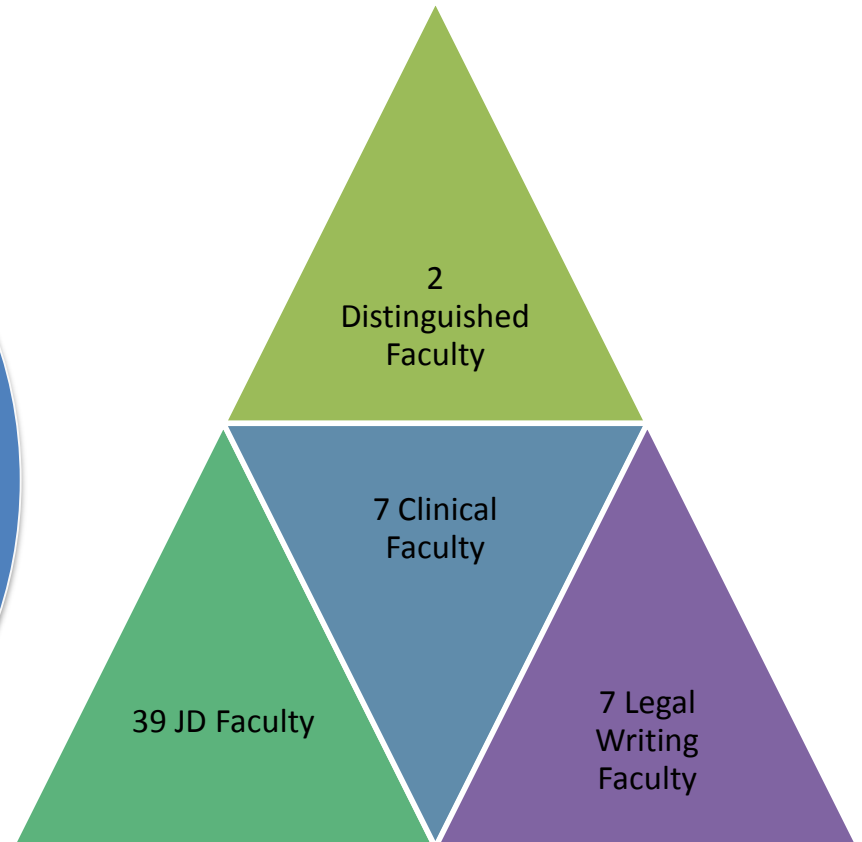
2015 Law School Graduate Employment

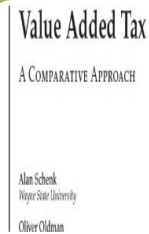

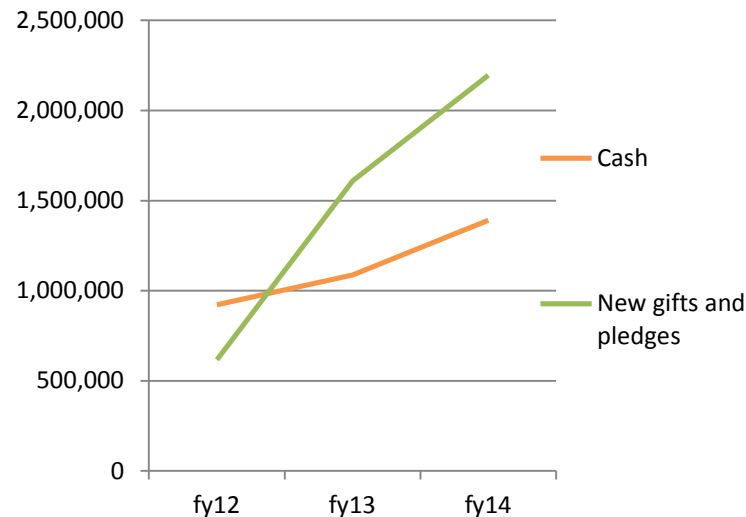

Generating Philanthropic Revenue

- **FY 2013:** \$1.1 million cash raised
 - Increase of \$164,000 over FY 2012
- **FY 2014:** \$1.4 million raised
 - Increase of \$303,000 over FY 2013
- **FY 2015:** Cash goal is \$2 million
 - Raised \$1,873,000 as of 8/2015
- **Engaging more alumni**
 - Created the “Dean’s Circle” – a \$1,000 or more giving circle.
 - Launched **Law Firm Challenge** – engaging alums at area law firms.
 - Hosting **Alumni Speaker Series** with weekly talks from area alums.
