




- Philip C. Jessup International Law Moot Court Team won U.S. Midwest Regional of Competition and Best Memorial and Best Oralist.

- Student Trial Advocacy Program won first place in the TYLA Regional competition, advancing to the Nationals round.







- **FY 2013:** \$1.1 million cash raised
 - Increase of \$164,000 over FY 2012
- **FY 2014:** \$1.4 million raised
 - Increase of \$303,000 over FY 2013
- **FY 2015**: Cash goal is \$2 million
 - Raised \$1,873,000 as of 8/2015
