




Fall 2015 Total Enrollment by Age



Average student age of 26 has remained constant since Fall 2011 when the average age was 27


#### Fall 2015 Total Enrollment by Geographical Origin

- No individual location changed more than 0.7% while most changed 0.2% or less.




#### Fall 2015 FTIAC Enrollment by Ethnicity

- No individual ethnicity changed more than 0.8% while most changed 0.6% or less.




Fall 2015 FTIAC Enrollment by Age



Average FTIAC student age has consistently remained 18


#### Fall 2015 FTIAC Enrollment by Geographical Origin

- No individual ethnicity changed more than 0.8% while most changed 0.4% or less.




#### Fall 2015 Undergraduate Enrollment by Ethnicity


Fall 2015 Undergraduate Enrollment by Age



• Average student age has slowly decreased from 25 since Fall 2010 and Fall 2011


#### Fall 2015 Undergraduate Enrollment by Geographical Origin

- No individual location changed more than 0.5% while most changed 0.2% or less.




#### Fall 2015 Graduate Enrollment by Ethnicity


Fall 2015 Graduate Enrollment by Age



• Average student age has slowly decreased from 33 since Fall 2010 and Fall 2011


#### Fall 2015 Graduate Enrollment by Geographical Origin




#### Fall 2015 Professional Enrollment by Ethnicity
