

- Approximately 4,000 prospective students received personalized handwritten notes which detailed the opportunities at Wayne State University and encouraged students to select the university for their higher education path. The Alumni Admissions Ambassadors wrote postcards from March 1 through April 30.
- The Alumni Association hosted a “Small Plates, Big Ideas” student-alumni networking lunch with Ron Wood, Vice President, BCBS of Michigan, on March 23, to discuss math careers.
- On March 27, the most recent installment of the Arthur L. Johnson Urban Perspectives Lecture Series was held at the Law School Partrich Auditorium. The program featured Chastity Pratt Dawsey from Bridge Magazine. She discussed public education in Detroit, the role the media plays in shaping public opinion, and the importance of a free and objective press during this time in the nation’s history. Co-presented by the WSU Alumni Association and the Irvin D. Reid Honors College, the event celebrated the 25th anniversary of the lecture series and the 10th anniversary of the Honors College. The evening concluded with an informal networking reception for attendees.
- A meeting was held on April 2 for alumni interested in joining the planning group for the LGBTQA Alumni Affinity Group.
- The Alumni Association hosted a table at the annual spring Grad Expo April 3-5 to congratulate graduating students, offer post-graduation resources, and collect contact information from them.
- The Detroit Presidential Alumni Reception was held on April 11 at the GEM Theatre in celebration of Wayne State University’s sesquicentennial.
