

FY 2019-20 Parking Rate Recommendation

Section 1: Recommendation for Board Action

It is recommended that the Board of Governors approve the FY 2020 parking rates as presented below. In summary, overall general student parking rates are not proposed to increase, while rates for faculty and staff are proposed to increase by approximately 3% and visitor and leased parking rates are proposed to increase by approximately 4-6%.

A summary of the parking rate increases are shown in the table below:

Section 2: Background Information

Parking and Transportation Services operates all university parking facilities and oversees the leased vehicle pool for use by university units. Parking and Transportation Services is a self-supporting auxiliary unit that covers its operating costs from revenues generated. It includes three services units:

- Parking Facilities – currently consists of eight (8) parking structures and Thirty (30) surface lots. The total parking system is approximately 12,600 spaces.
- Violations Bureau – the collection agency for parking violations.
- Transportation Services – manages all vehicles leased to university departments and oversees the shuttle services provided to the campus community.

A \$1 million general fund subsidy, first provided to Parking and Transportation Services in FY 2018, goes directly toward maintaining lower student parking rates. This subsidy is recommended to continue in FY 2020. Semester permits for students were reduced by 23% in FY 2018 and remain unchanged since that reduction.
