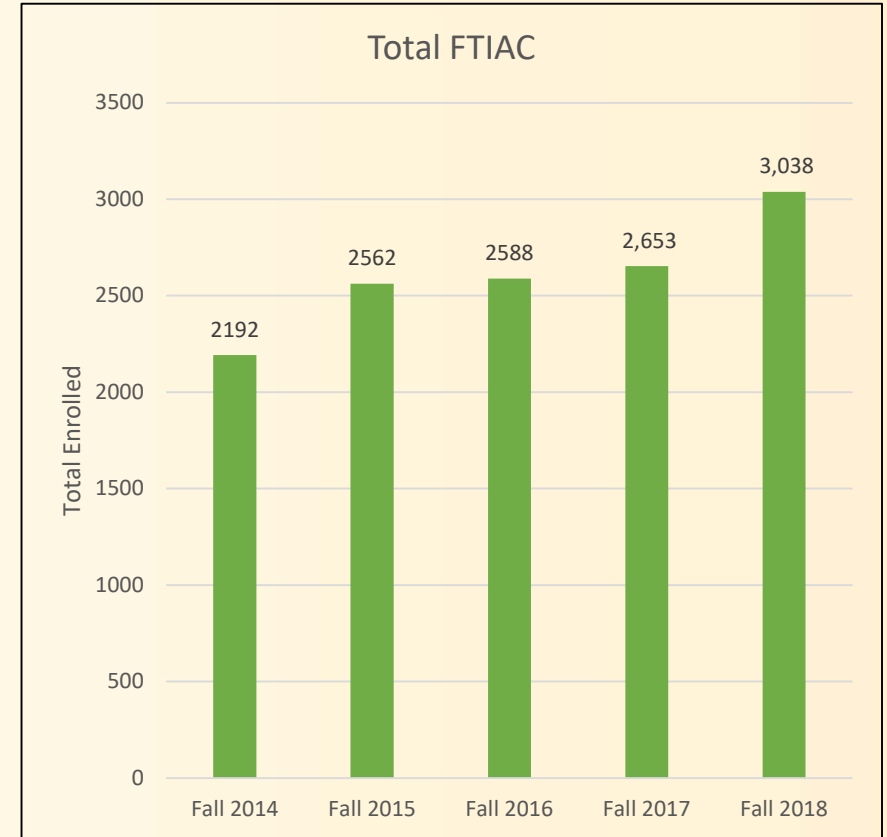

Undergraduate Enrollment

- Undergraduate enrollment increase from 17,322 to 17,602
 - FTIAC up from 2653 to 3038 14.5% increase
 - CC Transfers up 1210-1295
- **97% of FTIACs are full-time**
 - 23% growth in Full-Time FTIACS in 2 years
 - 2014 - 2098
 - 2015 - 2320
 - 2016 – 2398
 - 2017 – 2567
 - 2018 – 2957



2018 FTIAC Class Highlights

- Largest full-time freshman cohort in WSU History
- HS GPA 3.38 (2017--3.36)
- ACT 24 (2017--24) SAT 1113 (2017--1109)
- First Generation Increase 18% 816-965 (32%)
- Pell Eligible Increase 13% (48%) (Over 1200 ACCESS Eligible)
- Diversity Increases
 - Hispanics of any race – Increase 27.7% 155-198 (6.5%)
 - Black or African American – Increase 12.8% 429-484 (16%)
 - Two or more races – Increase 23.7% 114-141 (4.6%)
 - Doubled Native American from 5-10
