RATIFICATION OF ELECTRONIC VOTE
Authorization to Suspend Test Requirement

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of Governors ratify the action adopted by the Board of Governors by electronic vote on April 20, with a vote of 8-0. The action authorized temporary suspension of the standardized test score requirement for admissions for Fall 2020 (BOG Statute 2.34.09.020).

Background

The background on this request was distributed to the Board under separate cover. The temporary suspension covers students who are unable to take either the ACT or the SAT due to the public health crisis, as April 2020 test dates for this exam have been cancelled, and the June 2020 test dates may likely be cancelled. The suspension of the requirement is for Fall 2020 incoming FTIAC students who have not already taken either of the two exams.
