Criminal Justice Building and Parking Lot #11			
A public private-partnership with a development company, The Platform. Project consists of 69 residential units, 19,000 sf of retail and a 6,000 sf Wayne State art gallery in the Criminal Justice Building (CJB) along with 64 apartments, 48 condos and a 543 unit parking structure on Parking Lot #11.	\$ 3,520,000	Project was approved by the Board. CJB sold for \$2M in June 2018 and the developer, Platform, has leased the building to Tata Automotive, WeWork, with first floor retail space remaining. Tata Automotive and WeWork are both occupying their space. To support lease up, WSU entered into a long term parking agreement with Platform for 378 non-exclusive parking spaces assignable to Platform's lender. Per the development documents, WSU is to contribute \$2.4 million for the buildout of its 6,000 square feet art gallery on the first floor. The art gallery lease terms are being finalized and shall include a tenant allowance toward "white box" costs. Due to changes in market demand in the area and new development activity from Henry Ford and the Pistons, Platform has moved away from its initial development plan to build high end condos, apartments and a 500+ parking garage on WSU's Parking Lot #11. Instead, the development document was amended to allow an extension of Platform's design approval period to December 2020. This additional time will be used to reaccess market demands and contemplate a district parking solution rather than just a project parking solution.	2019/2021
Highland Park/ Engineering/ Development	unknown	Real Estate has completed its review of a draft lease agreement from the N. Rachmale Foundation. Draft copies have been forwarded to Development, WSU General Counsel and Risk Management for review. The donor, a Wayne State Engineering graduate, N. Rachmale has agreed to donate \$4 million towards building out a 8,000 square foot structure and materials lab to the University's specifications. Terms include initial 20-year term, with an option to renew for an additional 20 years. Rent would be \$1.00 per year during the first five years of the term. However, during the lease term, WSU would be responsible for paying for utility, maintenance and operating expenses associated with the lease space. WSU's Development Department is working with the donor to establish a gift agreement.
