## Parking Structure #6 - Repairs and Maintenance

#### Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of Governors authorize the President, or her designee, to approve spending to design, solicit bids, and award contracts for Parking Structure #6 Repairs and Maintenance with a cost not to exceed \$2,181,000. Funding for this project will be provided from parking revenues.

# **Background and Project Description**

The WSU Parking Structure No. 6 (61 Putnam) was built in 2001 and has approximately 694 parking spaces. Parking is available to students, guests, visitors, and others as assigned. The structure has six supported levels and a total of 208,000 square feet.

The project scope includes structural concrete repairs to floors, columns, beams, and walls; post-tensioned tendon repairs; expansion joint replacement; recoating waterproofing; drainage improvements; stair tower repairs; exterior sealants; and other repair, maintenance, and improvement items.

The contract for this project will be awarded in accordance with university policies and procedures.
