



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




Improved Graduation Rates. Reduced Time to degree.






6-year Graduation Rate Trend By Race/Ethnicity: Gaps Persist

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


6-year Graduation Rate Trend vs Peers 2019-2022




1st to 2nd Year Retention Rate Trend vs Select Peers 2019-2022


1st to 2nd Year Retention Rate Equity Gap (White-Black)


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1st to 3rd year Retention Rate Equity Gap Persists
