Teaching, Learning and Student Success: The Heart of Our University


Goal 1: Educate the next generation for a rapidly changing and increasingly connected world.









Improved Graduation Rates. Reduced Time to degree.



Student Success Strategic Initiatives Timeline: What's Next?




6-year Graduation Rate Trend By Race/Ethnicity: Gaps Persist








1st to 2nd Year Retention Rate Trend vs Select Peers 2019-2022







1st to 2nd Year Retention Rate Equity Gap (White-Black)
